ELECTRICAL AND HYBRID VEHICLE ENGINEERING EVENING COURSES

City & Guilds Level 3 Award Requirements for Electrical Installation (18th Edition)

10 weeks

This course is aimed at practicing electricians and domestic installers and for professionals such as contracts managers, designers, electrical engineers, surveyors, and other related trades needing to update and enhance their understanding of the IEE Wiring Regulations.

EAL Advanced Award In-Service Inspection and Testing of Electrical Equipment (PAT)

3 weeks

This course is aimed at electricians who have the necessary knowledge, skills and experience needed to avoid danger to themselves and others and want to qualify and be registered to carry out Portable Appliance Testing (PAT).

Level 3 Award Combined Initial Verification and Periodic Inspection and Testing

12 weeks

This qualification will provide you with the specialist knowledge and skills you need, including appropriate legislation, inspection and testing techniques, completing and issuing certificates or reports and understanding of results and measurements.

IMI Level 2 Award Hybrid Electric Vehicle Operation and Maintenance

7 weeks

This course is designed for technicians who maintain and repair hybrid technology vehicles. It contains the knowledge required to work safely around a vehicle's hybrid system, whilst carrying out repairs or maintenance.

Diploma Level 2 Award Plumbing Studies

34 weeks
